

# Summer Meals Feeds Good Nutrition to Our Kids for FREE

With summer right around the corner, it's time to think about keeping children healthy while school is out. The Salvation Army provides free meals to children during the summer. This summer, meals will be served at 11 locations throughout Licking County, from June 5 – August 11, 2017.

Each location has specific times; however, lunch will be available Monday – Friday (except July 4<sup>th</sup>) at all locations. There are no income requirements or registration. Anyone age 18 or younger may come to eat. For more information, contact 740-345-8120. Each year, the United States Department of Agriculture (USDA) partners with local organizations like The Salvation Army, to provide free meals to children when school is out for the summer. Free meals will be made available to all children 18 years of age and under or persons over 18 who are determined by a state or local public educational agency to be mentally or physically disabled.
